Thurs 30th March	Teaching Pyramid Observation Tool reliability Training (TPOT) Part 1	QVWC	9.30am-4.30pm	<p>The Teaching Pyramid Observation Tool (TPOT™) reliability workshop prepares participants in the use of the instrument to gather information on educator implementation of the Pyramid Model practices.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• This is an intensive workshop that requires prerequisite knowledge, preparation, and participation in the entire 2-day workshop.</li> <li>• Participants who successfully complete the workshop and meet reliability standards will receive a certificate indicating reliability status and can serve as reliability partners to other observers.</li> <li>• Successful completion will indicate that the TPOT workshop participant is reliable with the instrument development team.</li> </ul> <p>During the 2-day workshop, participants will learn:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• how to use TPOT instrument with a focus on key definitions and scoring guidance</li> <li>• about the scoring of indicators</li> <li>• how to observe and score the TPOT to check for reliability with the gold standard score</li> </ul>
