Culturally Responsive Practices to Reduce Implicit Bias- 2 hours (90 day Access)- \$47AUD

- Identify culturally responsive practices in enhancing outcomes for all children, especially those from diverse backgrounds.
- Consider the role of implicit bias in our work with children and families.
- Understand the 7 principles of culturally responsive practices that help us recognize implicit bias.
- Consider values of the family and community to inform teaching and learning thru Pyramid Model lens.

Wellness: Taking Care of Yourself- 2 hours (90 day Access)----- \$47AUD

- Understand the impact of adult well-being on children's social emotional development.
- Identify symptoms of stress, compassion fatigue, secondary trauma and vicarious trauma.
- Learn strategies for reducing stress and increasing wellness.
- Understand how mindfulness can reduce stress and improve well-being. Develop a self-care plan.

Trauma-Informed Care & the Pyramid Model - 5 hours (180 day Access)----- \$60 AUD

- Assists teachers to understand the impact of trauma on young children and their families and to recognize the signs and symptoms of trauma in young children.
- Ensures teachers understand the assumptions and principles of trauma-informed care.
- Builds a foundation to support children's resilience and recovery.

Prevent-Teach-Reinforce for Young Children - 8 hours (365 day Access)----- \$77AUD

This course, along with the PTR-YC manual, introduces the five steps of the PTR-YC model: 1) teaming and goal setting; 2) data collection; 3) functional behavioral assessment; 4) development and implementation of a behavior intervention plan; and 5) using data, arranging for generalization, and next steps.
